

## PROTECTIVE GEAR (HELMETS) - POLICY

In the 'Dictionary' of the Australian Rules of Harness Racing, the definition of a driver, "means a person who is on a racetrack or a registered or unregistered training track for the purpose of driving or riding a horse"

Australian Harness Racing Rules 159A (1) and (2) refer to the requirements of a person to have an approved helmet fitted and correctly fastened when driving or riding a horse.

## **Australian Harness Racing Rules**

- **159A.** (1) A driver shall wear a helmet which has been approved and entered in the Register of Helmets approved by Harness Racing Australia.
- (2) A driver shall at all times when driving or riding a horse keep his or her helmet correctly fastened.

## **Harness Racing Victoria Policy**

Harness Racing Victoria (HRV) policy in relation to ARHR 159A (1) & (2) applies to any licensed person or track attendant who parades a horse in the drivers' absence, prior to or after a race / trial. The requirement is that such person is required to have a helmet fitted and correctly fastened, whilst being seated in the sulky.
